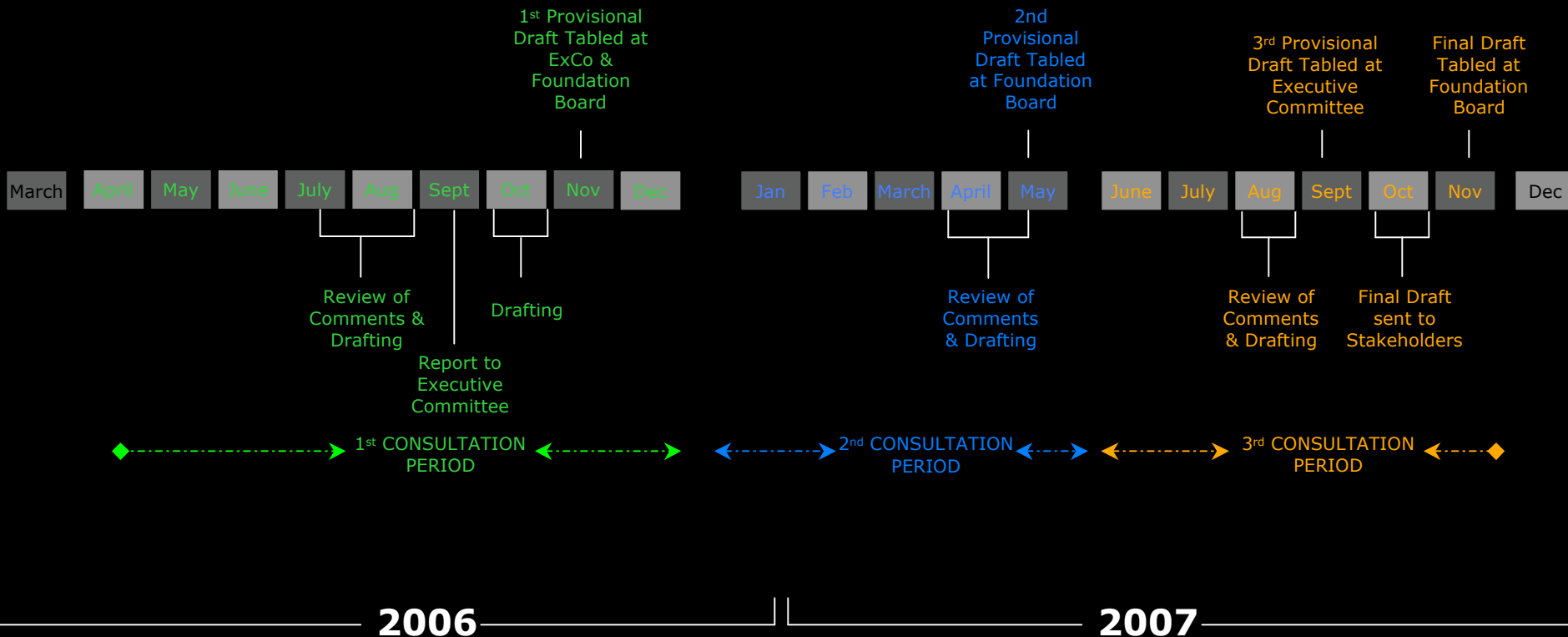

Code Revisions



- Changes to sanctions:
 - Increase flexibility downwards
 - Increase level of sanction upwards
 - Clarify sanction for 2nd infraction

Code Revisions



- Tighten rules for missed tests and failure to provide whereabouts
- Review of TUE
- New definition of athlete

Code Revisions

- Mandatory education programs



Code Revisions

- Provisional suspensions mandatory



Code Revisions



- Incentives to admit
- Encouragement to come forward

Code Revisions

- Recognition of financial sanctions



Code Revisions

- “Atypical” findings – not adverse



Code Revisions

- Consequences to teams



Code Revisions

- Appeal rights to WADA more efficient



Code Revisions

- Ineligibility to host events if country not ratified, or NADO/NOC not compliant



Code Revisions

- Effective start date
January 1, 2009



Code Revisions



- Inclusion of a provision on the protection of personal data
- Development of an international standard on data protection
