





# Methodology

The **Fett Growth Model** after Barro:

GDP per capita growth<sub>i,t</sub> = 
$$\mu + \alpha_i + \theta \ FIFA \ Host + \gamma_j \mathbf{D}_{j,t} + \beta_i \mathbf{X}_{i,t} + \lambda_t + \varepsilon_{i,t}$$

- Fixed Effects model
- Panel Data

i = country t = time  $\mu$  = constant  $\alpha_i$  = time-fixed constant  $\theta$  = FIFA Host Effect  $\gamma_j$  = Effects of Preparation and Legacy  $D_{j,t}$  = Dummy variable matrix  $\beta_i$  = Effects of economic variables  $X_{i,t}$  = Economic variable matrix  $\lambda_t$  = country-fixed constant  $\varepsilon_{i,t}$  = error-term

## Hypothesis

The FIFA World Cup was not profitable in the past, but it is today.

GDP per capita growth<sub>i,t</sub> =  $\mu + \alpha_i + \theta$  FIFA Host +  $\gamma_j \mathbf{D}_{j,t} + \beta_i \mathbf{X}_{i,t} + \lambda_t + \varepsilon_{i,t}$ 


- 2 samples: European and Non-European countries
- time period:1991-2014

#### Results I

	European	Non-European
t-4	0.544	-1.345
t-3	0.166	1.004
t-2	0.960	0.992
t-1	1.257	-0.475
FIFA Host	2.752***	1.588***
t+1	1.804***	0.569
t+2	0.844	1.143
t+3	-1.804	0.620
t+4	2.011*	1.230**
constant	1.014	1.388



#### Policy Recommendations

- Statement of IBSA Forum cannot be rejected.
- The contemporary belief that FIFA World Cups have no or negative effects on the economy can be statistically rejected, but only for the time after 1990.
- Statistically significant positive results can be incentives for bribery in the bidding process.
